

In the matter of J. Bradley Teets v. American Family

On June 25, 2007, a jury in the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis, Missouri delivered a unanimous verdict in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for J. Bradley Teets, a former American Family agent from Jackson, Missouri, against American Family for breach of contract. At the time his Agent Agreement was terminated by American Family, Mr. Teets had been an agent for over 21 years. American Family claimed that a "six month notice of undesirable performance" given to Mr. Teets in 12/2000 for "customer service" was the only letter American Family was required to give prior to terminating his Agent Agreement in July of 2003, three and a half years later. Mr. Teets was represented by Rose Ann Feldman and Denise Bloch.
