We did everything possible to support the troops in the field. Amfam referred to the agents as the "field force." I believe Amfam has implemented procedures not to support the field force, but to actually destroy them. It was 50 years ago today that I was on a troop transport plane for my deployment to Vietnam. This is also the date that Martin Luther King Jr. had been assassinated.
